







When it comes to fun things to do while on vacation, you can't beat Beijing. China's capital is fun for the young--and the young at heart.

They range from climbing on the Great Wall to panda watching at the zoo to ringing bells at the Big Bell or Yonghegong Lama temples.




Boys and girls can dress up as emperors and empresses at places like the Summer Palace and Forbidden City.
