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ARRIVAL AT RIO'S AIRPORT

How do I get into town? Choose either the Executive or Normal taxi. This nice lady will sell you a ticket for the Executive car. You will be in

Centro, the local term for Rio's downtown, in 30 minutes or in Copacabana and Ipanema in 40 minutes.



Another option is the Real bus. It departs from the first floor of the building.

In case you are going from the airport directly to the Olympic Park, get on the Transcarioca BRT Bus.

From the Park to the Deodoro Venue, site of the Equestrian and BMX events, take the Transolimpica BRT Bus Line.




Rio's transport system has been completely modernized to coincide with the arrival of thousands of tourists...




... and has also become a city of statues, like Tom Jobim, figures from the past and present.



See the girls from Ipanema made famous by the Brazil's famous Bossa Nova composer.




No major tourist city could be without an exciting nightlife district, like Lapa.
