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
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
Tour Summary


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Introduction


There's a hot mineral springs for everyone, including a geothermal pool that tops even Iceland's famed Blue Lagoon!

You don't even have to bring a bathing suit - you can buy a one-time-wear swimsuit onsite!




On this tour you can "get into hot water" at Colorado's 4 most popular hot springs lodgings, in Glenwood Springs, Nathrop, Moffat, and Idaho Springs. Ideally, you can visit all 4 in 7 days, with ample time to enjoy each one.



First, you'll travel directly to the gem of Colorado's blue lagoons, at Glenwood Hot Springs Lodge and Pool. Here is the largest outdoor geothermal swimming pool in the world!




Then drop over the Continental Divide to the family-style Mt. Princeton Hot Springs Resort.

Finally, enjoy a mud bath and geothermal swim at Indian Hot Springs, a memorable treat saved for last, before returning to Denver.
