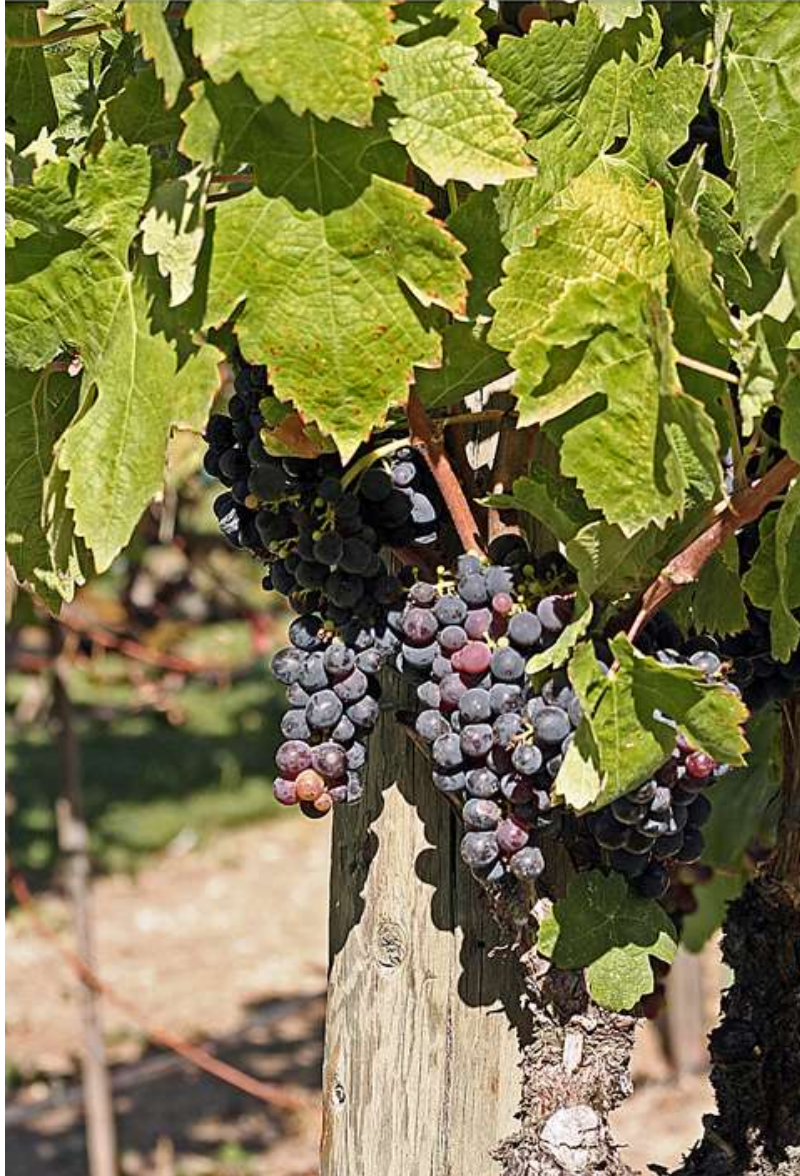
Tour Summary

Paso Robles on the Central Coast of California is considered the fastest growing American Viticulture Area in the state. With more than 180 wineries it now rivals the northern wine regions of Napa and Sonoma. Many of these vineyards are located in the hilly country west of town and are referred to as The Far Out Wineries. Specializing in Rhone varietals, winemakers here have found the hidden secret is in the calcareous soil. Visitors will thrill to the variety in the tasting rooms, delight to a stay in unusual bed and breakfasts, and enjoy exploring the historical and natural wonders of the region.

A variety of celebrations are held throughout the year, from wine festivals to an old-fashioned threshing bee.



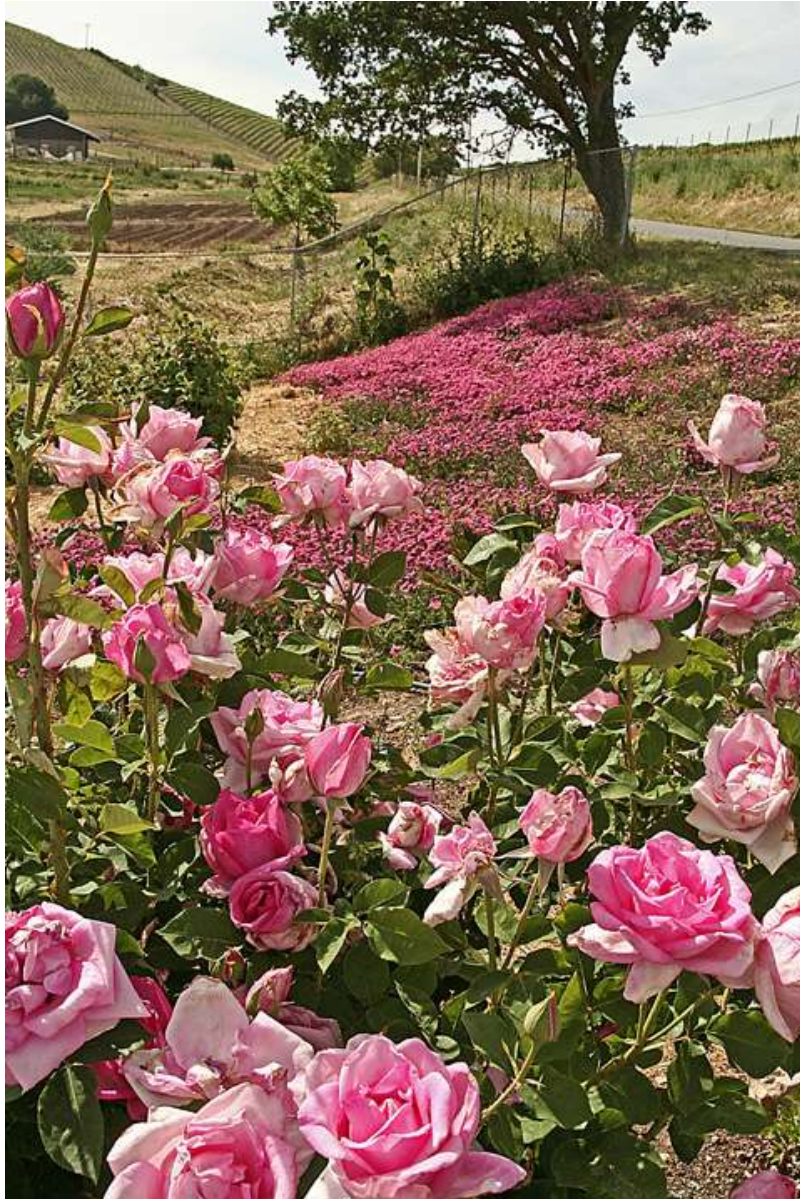
A trip to the zoo is on our agenda, where we will see exotic and local wildlife.
