

Mission Highlights

- Magnificent architecture of the church façade and convent
- Breathtaking church interior with its Colonial-era art and sculptures (the only Mission church with a crypt under the sanctuary where Franciscan friars and early settlers are interred)
- Historic Cemetery & Mausoleum

PLUS a special visit to the Della Robbia glazed terra cotta tableau shrine Madonna & Saints, and the opportunity to meet a Franciscan Friar!

- Nine-room Museum of Art and Artifacts, including:
- Chumash Room featuring Native American artifacts, along with traditional crafts and tools
- Re-creation of a 17th century kitchen with original 1790s adobe wall. 1805 front stone wall
- Lone Woman of San Nicolas Island (Juana Maria) exhibit room
- Trades Room with agricultural, blacksmithing and weaving tools, as well as historical mission-era photos
- Treasures Room with beautiful original Chumash altar.


MISSION EXTERIOR WALK: APP
